HIGHWAY REPORT

- Two major storms which downed limbs, branches and power lines.
- Opened up the private roads in West Town with the backhoe.
- Checked all areas for flooding after storm.
- Will continue to repair pothole damage from winter.

SUPERVISORS REPORT

- North County Water and Joint Operations meeting will be held Thursday, March 22nd.
- Received a letter from USDA announcing that a loan of \$587,000 and a grant of \$728,000 were approved by Rural Development for Water Service Area #1.
